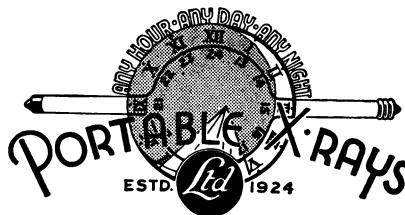

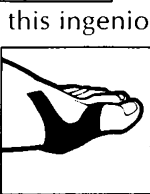

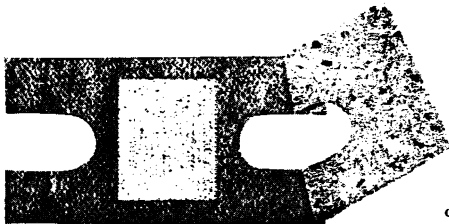

FLU WAS BAD ENOUGH LAST YEAR
